During course hours and school functions

Registration Day – Orientation

Business casual to business formal

Students are required to wear name badges at all times while in the classroom or at the fields.

Between January 3 – 9, 2018

Comfortable umpire and/or athletic apparel. Athletic or umpire shoes with appropriate tread. Umpire school student-issued hat.

Effective January 10, 2018

- Daily wear (includes classroom, drills, control games, and cage work)
 - Grey umpire base pants (can be your own or umpire school student-issued)
 - Black tee shirt
 - Umpire school student-issued hat
 - Black belt
 - Black socks
 - Athletic or umpire shoes with appropriate tread
 - Umpire school student-issued jacket (optional)
- Live games
 - Grey umpire pants (can be your own or umpire school student-issued, and may be plate pants)
 - Black tee shirt
 - Umpire school student-issued hat (not required if on the plate with a hockey-style mask)
 - Black belt
 - Ball bag(s) (if working the plate)
 - Black socks
 - Athletic supporter and cup
 - Athletic or umpire shoes with appropriate tread (plate shoes are optional when working the plate)
 - Umpire school student-issued uniform shirt (optional)
 - Umpire school student-issued jacket (optional)
